1. Common Core Curriculum Initiative: Math

Director of Student Services Martha Ryan-Toye provided an update about the planned implementation timeline for the math curriculum, including professional development for teachers.

She noted shifts in the standards and methods for teaching math that are changing how schools must approach their math curriculum. Teachers will be receiving continuing professional development to match these shifts. There was discussion about providing parents with information about the changes so they understand the terminology and process.

2. STEM Programming Update
