Adoption of 2017 Tax Levy – Mr. Cozzi described the requirements under the Truth in Taxation Act. The District was not required to conduct a formal public hearing on the tax levy, which would have been required if the increase was greater than 5% of the prior years' extension. The current year proposed levy is an increase 3.0% from the prior years' extension. Mr. Cozzi also described the amount of the levy as being equal to the estimated levy that was approved in November.

BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING CALENDAR AMENDED

Proposed Board of Education Ad Hoc Gender Inclusion

Committee – Mr. Martire and Dr. Condon proposed creating an ad hoc Gender Inclusion Committee to lead Board-level exploration into any potential modifications to Board policy, administrative procedure and school processes relative to gender identity issues. They hoped to get two Board members to lead the process with the Equity Committee structure as a model.

Student Walking Routes to School – Dr. Condon spoke about the ongoing efforts to make walking routes to school as safe as possible for students. He noted that the Village of River Forest administration has offered to meet with District officials to discuss any assistance needed to complete the task successfully. Mr. Martire publicly thanked the Village administration for their willingness to partner with this matter.

Policy, First Reading – Ms. Williams and Dr. Condon gave the first reading of the PRESS Policy Updates from the Fall of 2017. A Board discussion ensued.

Administrative Staffing Overview – Dr. Condon presented an overview of Administrative staffing and how District 90 measures up against comparable school districts. Mr. Martire thought it was important to analyze staffing knowing that deficit spending is on the horizon.

Memorandum of Understanding, Park District

Intergovernmental Agreement – Mr. Cozzi shared information about the District's request to include language in the recently adopted Intergovernmental Agreement with the River Forest Park District, which will amend and clarify information pertaining to insurance coverage through the use of an MOU. The Board came to consensus that the MOU should be executed.
