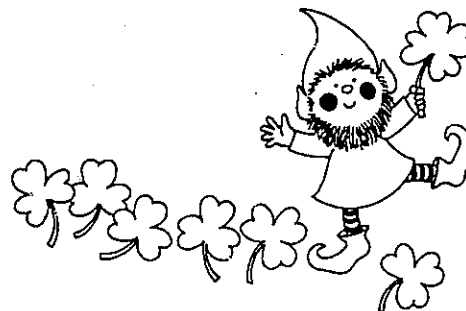
ARE YOU MOVING? Please let the office know if your child will not be attending Lincoln next school year.
