Our students are high achievers, with 77 percent of all students meeting or exceeding the Illinois Learning Standards in reading, and 63 percent in math. District 90 schools have won numerous Academic Excellence Awards, recognizing superior academic achievement sustained over time.

All teachers in the District are ranked "highly qualified" by the Illinois Department of Education. The average teaching experience of the District's full-time teachers is 13 years, with 87.5 percent holding master's degrees.

District 90 enjoys a high level of support from the community, which has allocated significant resources to maintain excellent staff, facilities, and programs. The District's per-pupil operating expenditure is \$15,321, with the majority of the budget going directly toward instructional expenses.

In addition to offering an engaging, well-rounded curriculum, our schools also offer programs for academically talented students and students with special needs. District 90 schools are well known for exceptional art and music programs, and we offer Spanish, French, and Italian. We have a popular and well-attended summer school program as well.
