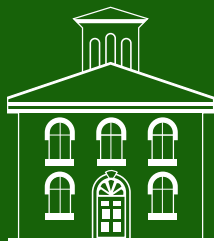

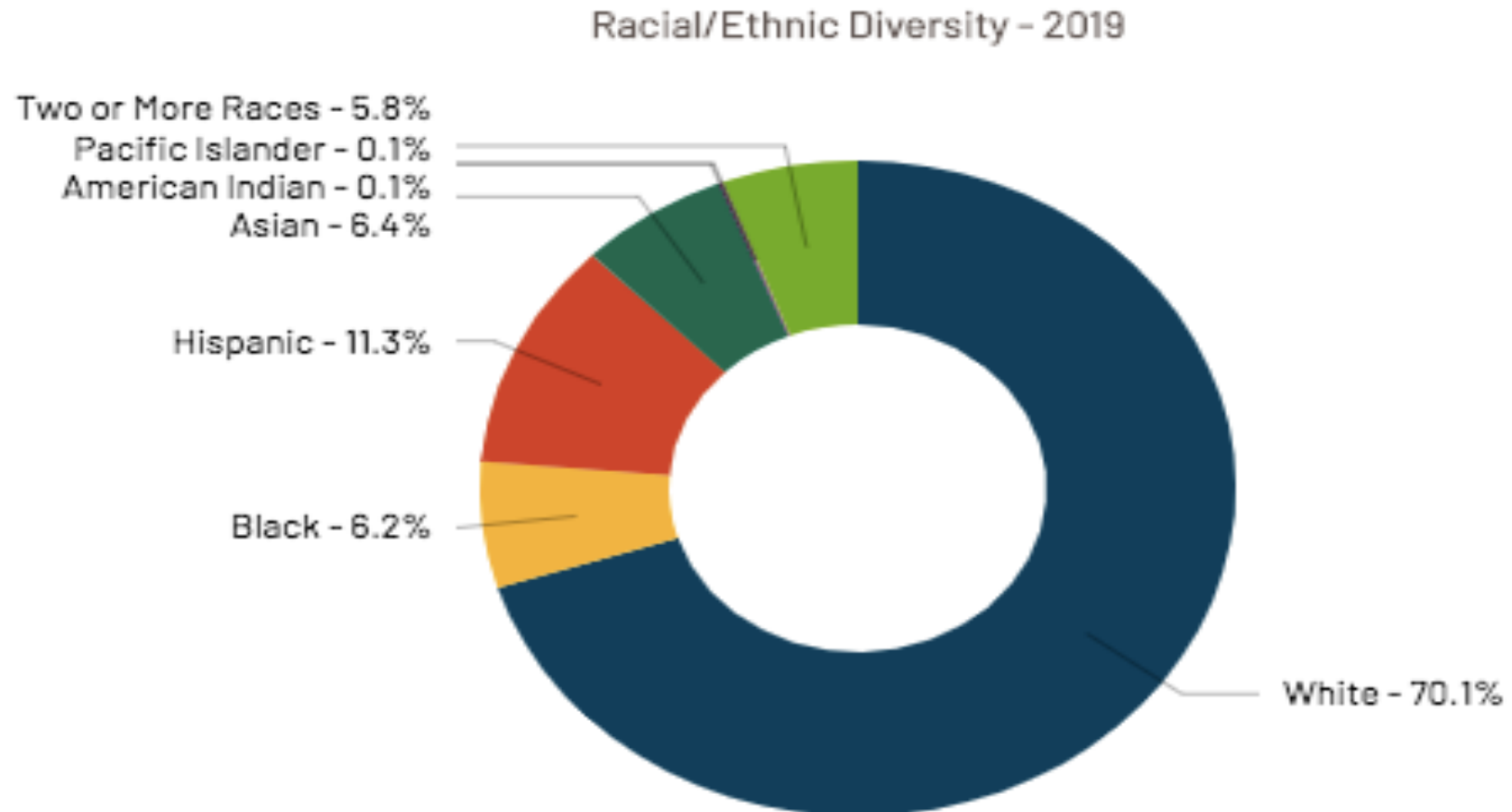

# Student Demographic Data: Race/Ethnicity

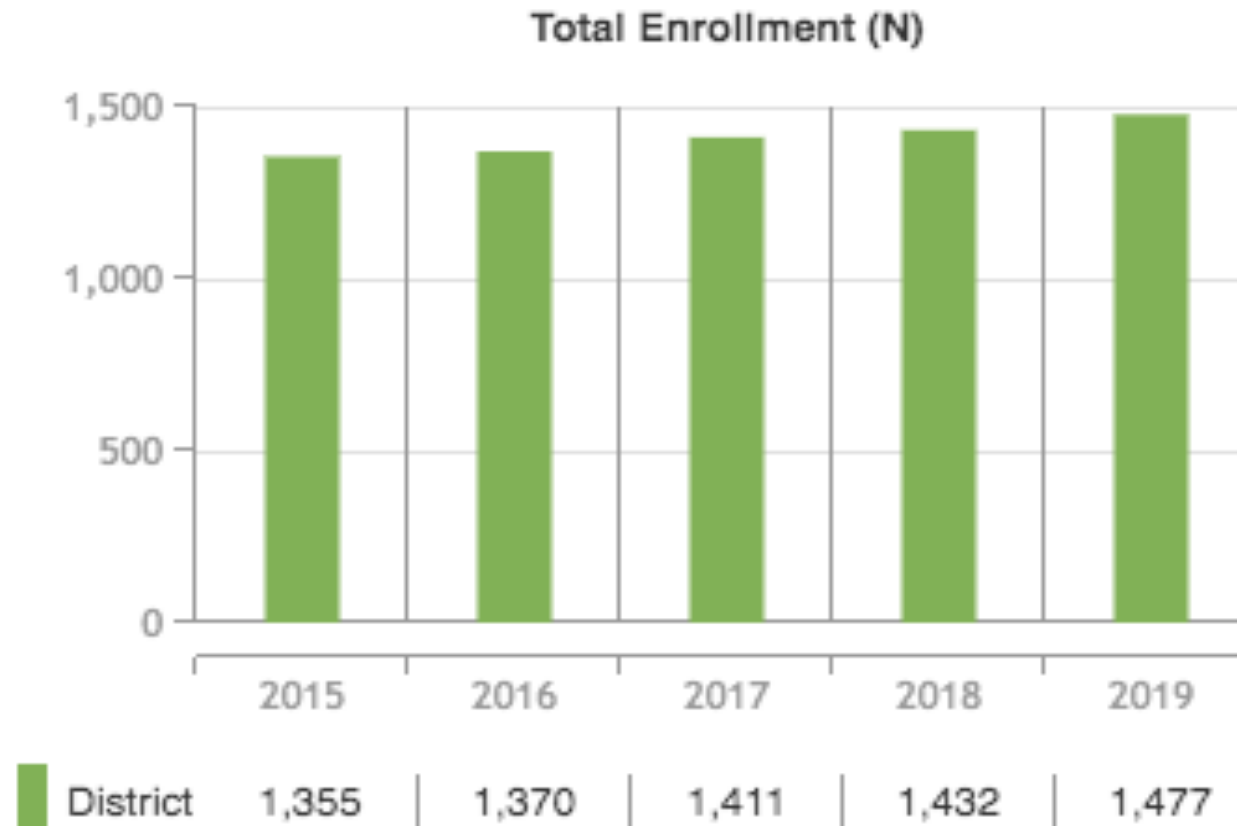
Percentage of students belonging to a particular racial/ethnic group

## Enrollment

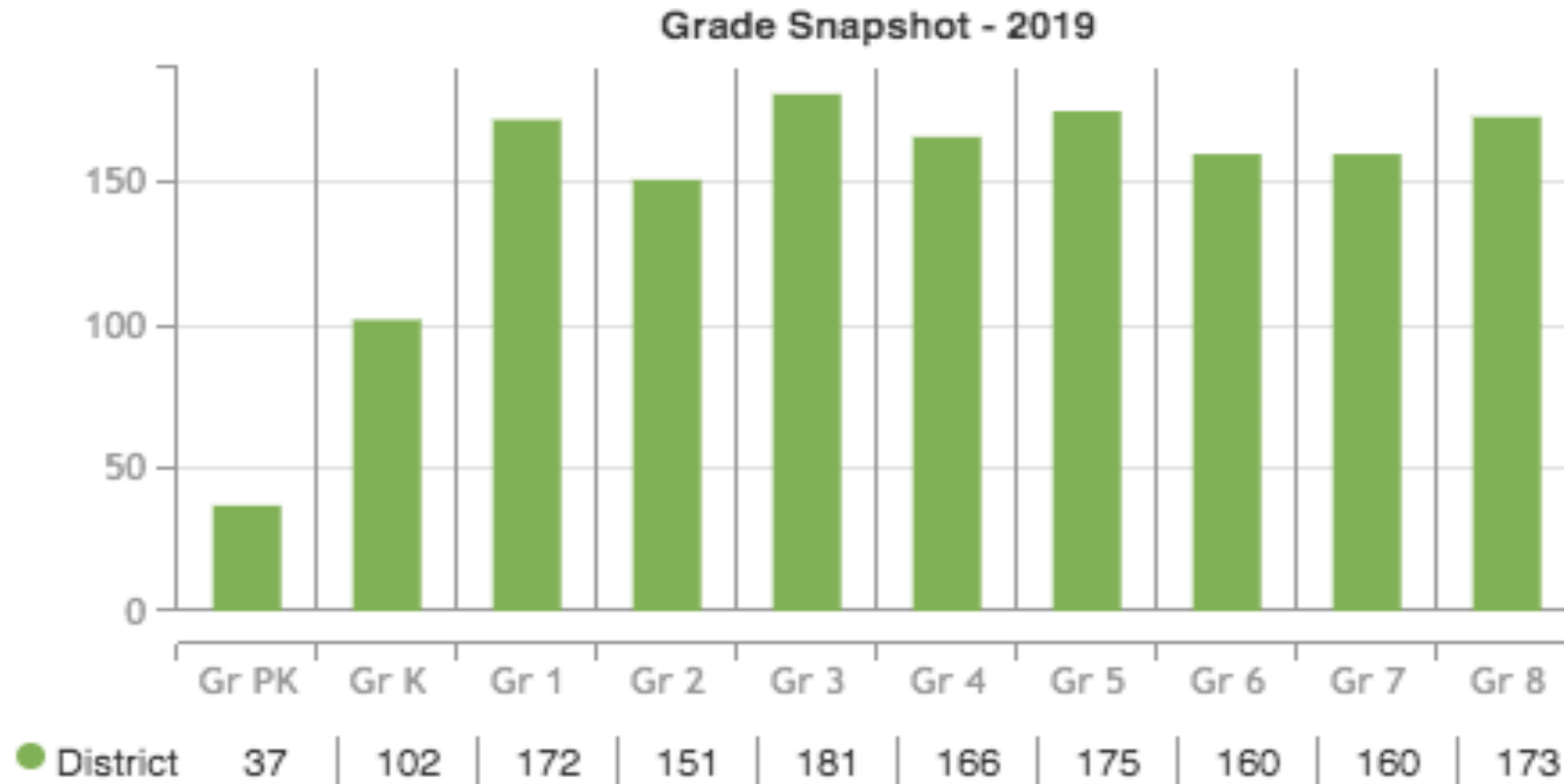
The total number of students enrolled

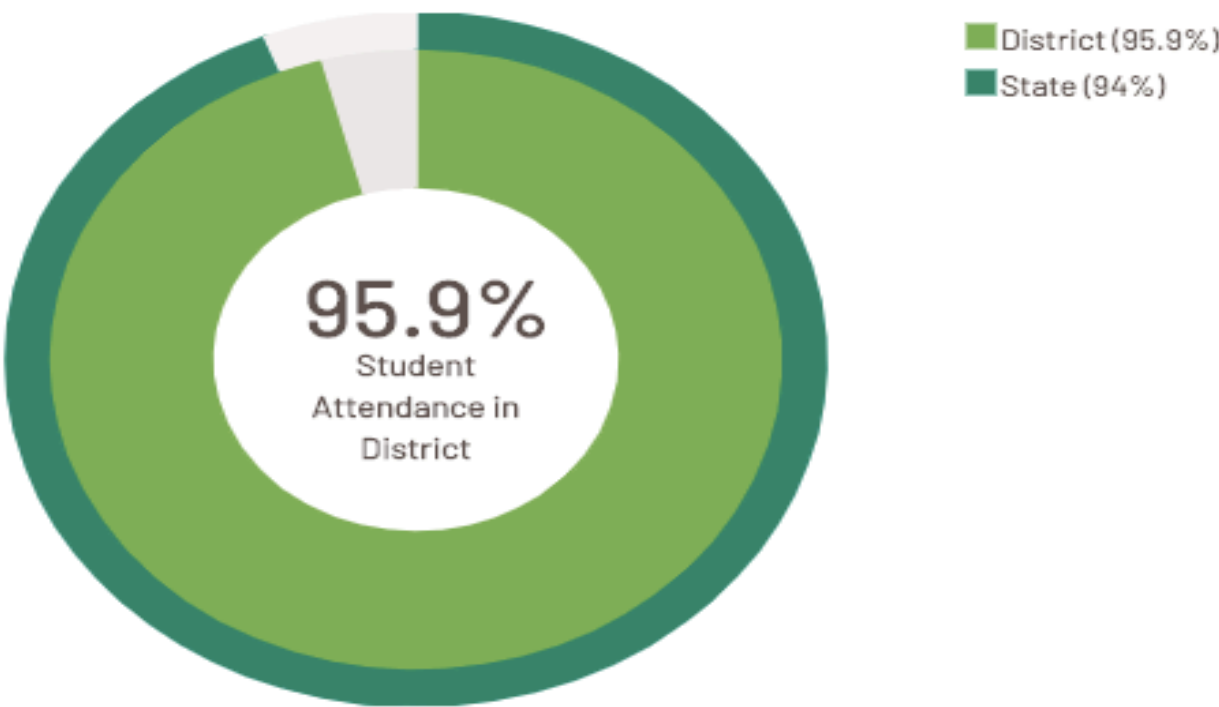

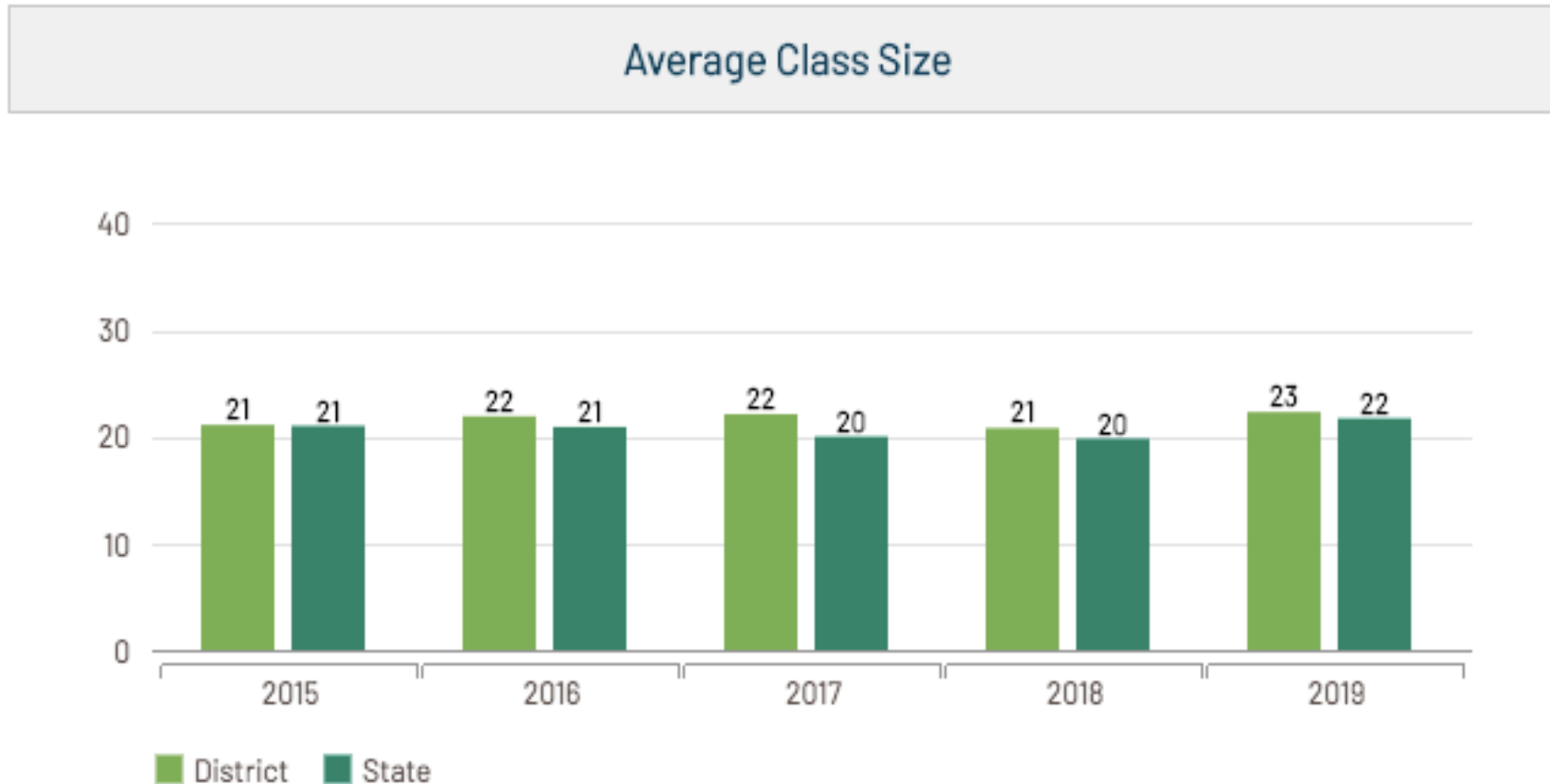

Average number of students per class



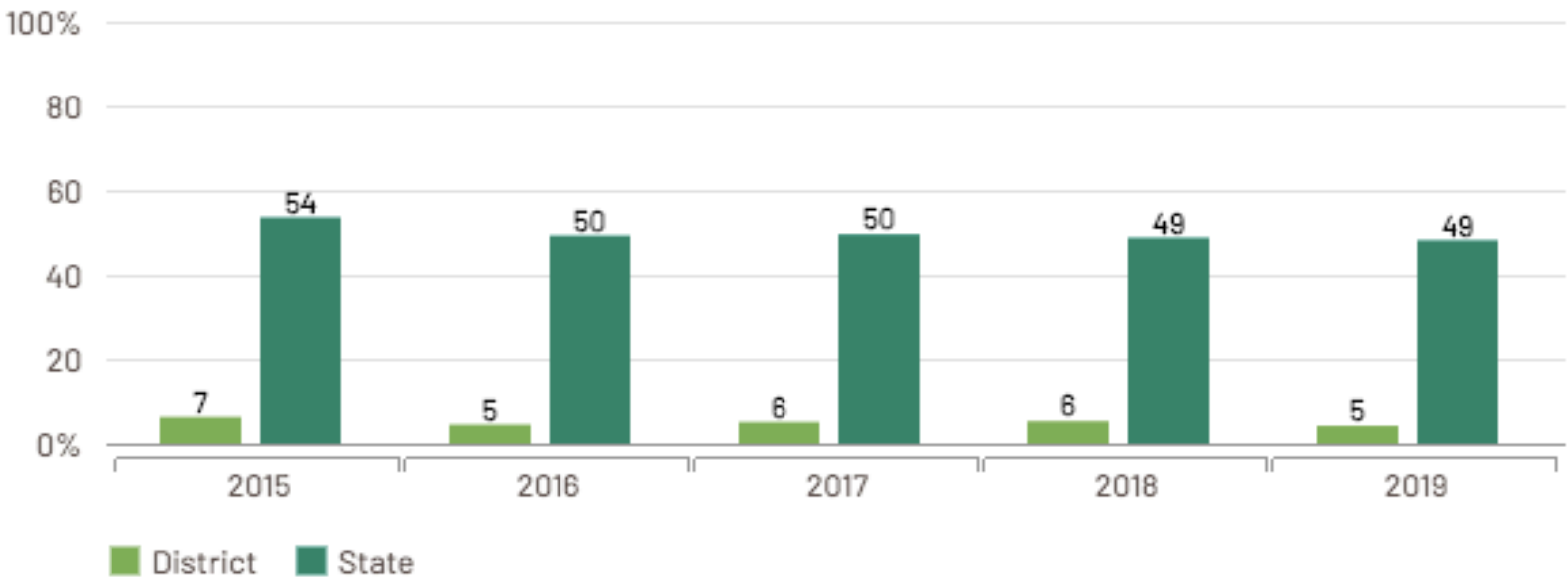

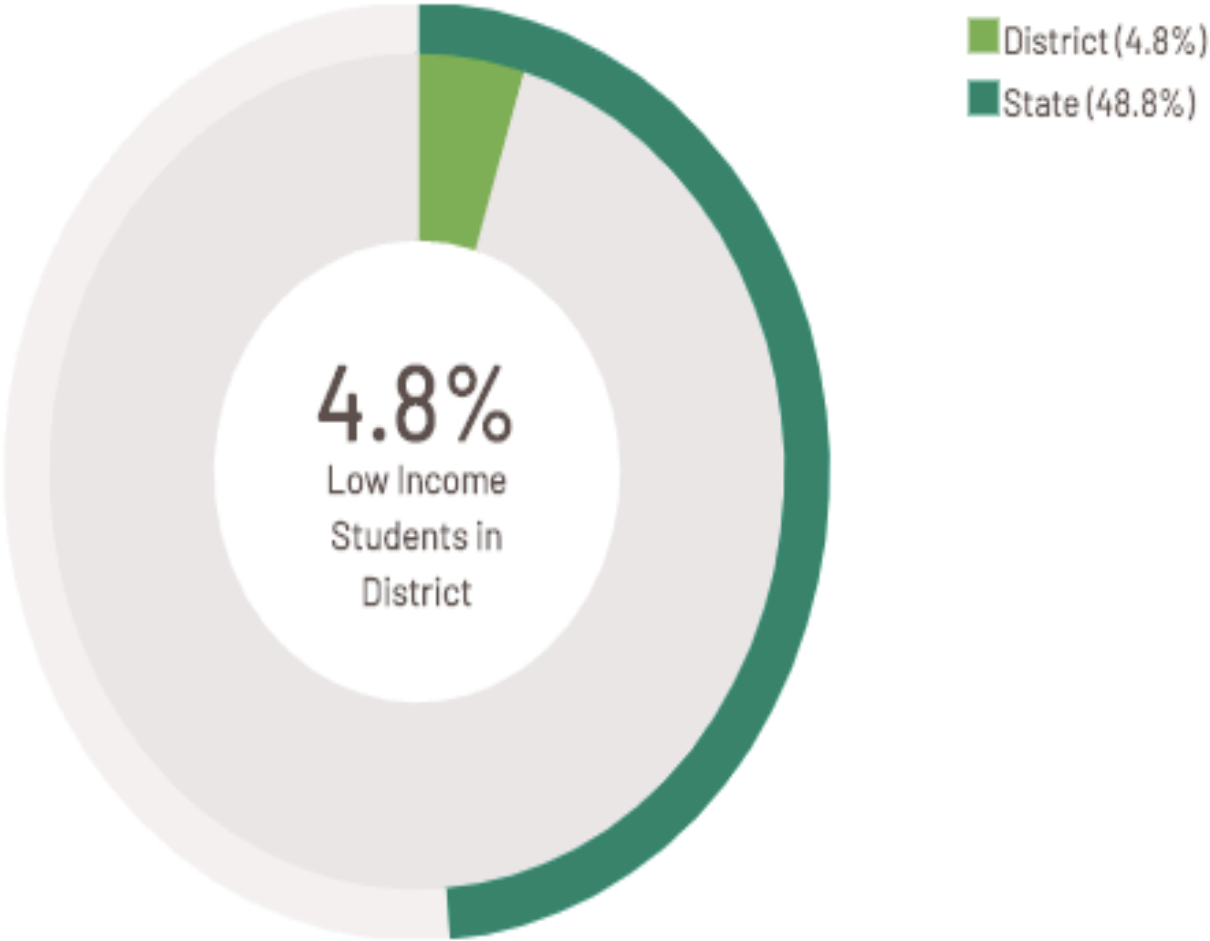

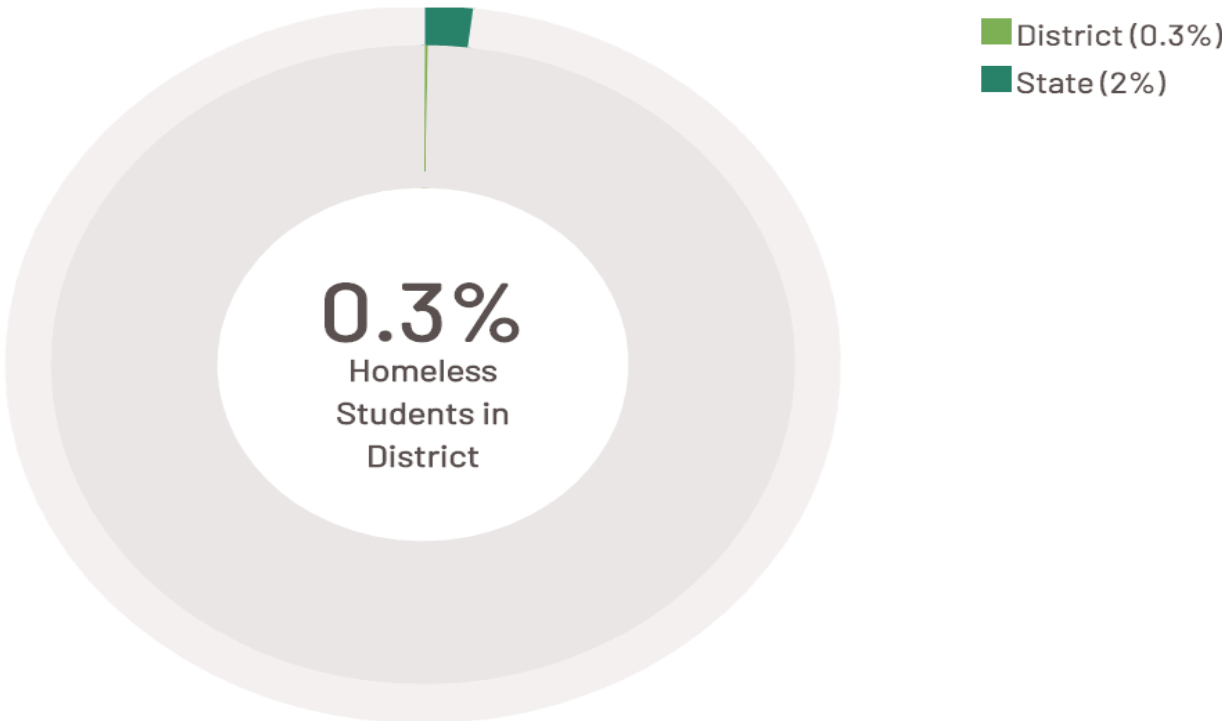


# Student Demographic Data: Homeless Students

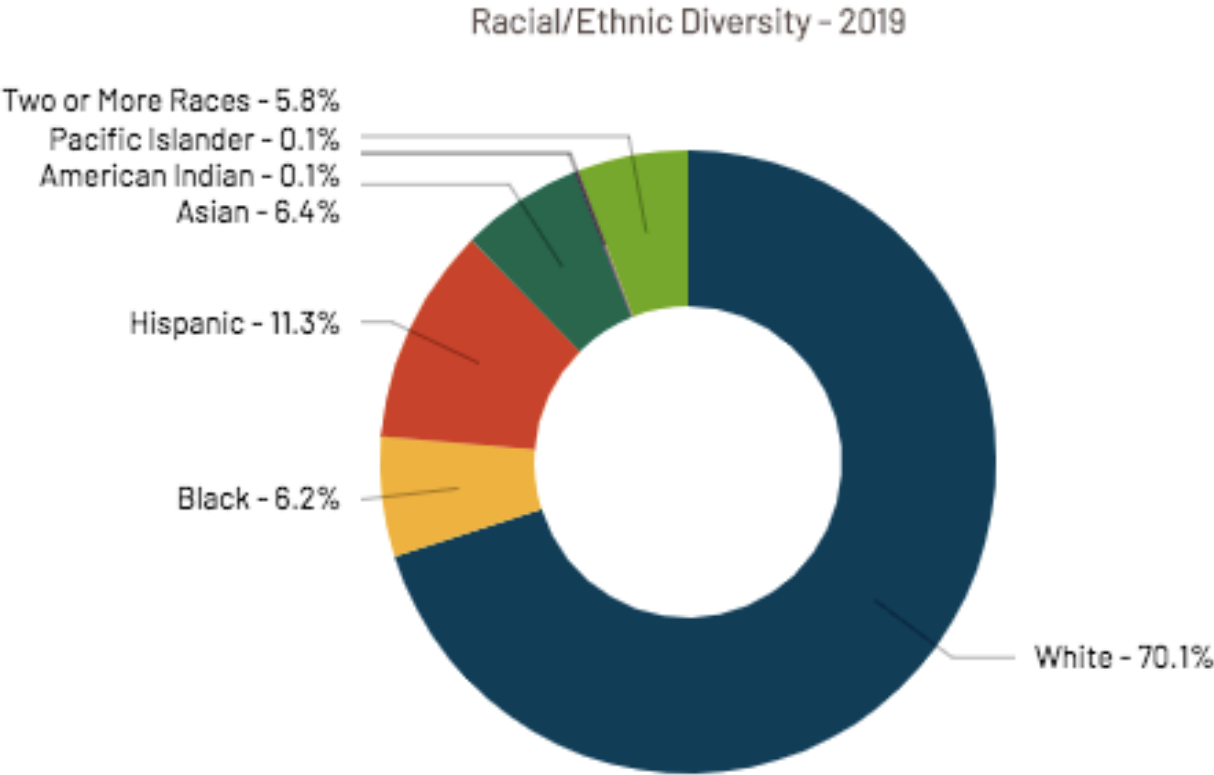

Racial/Ethnic Diversity

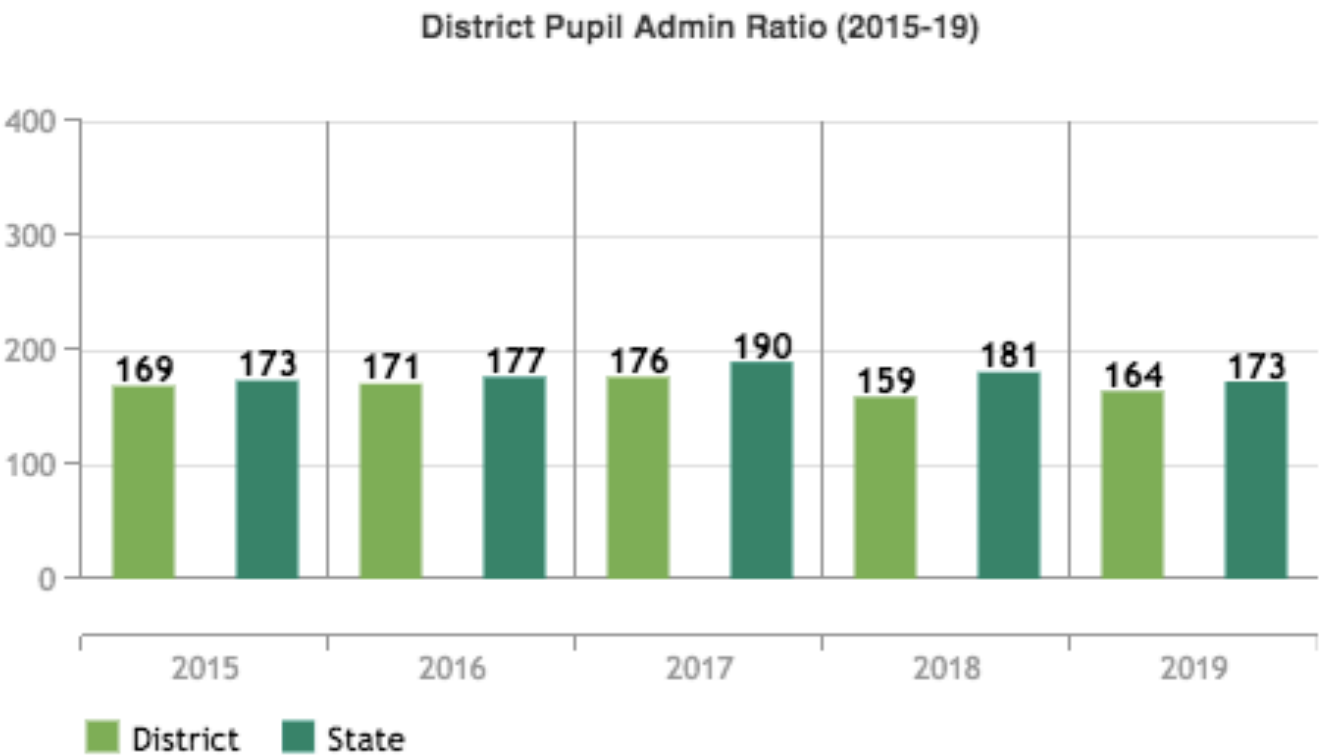
Percentage of students belonging to a particular racial/ethnic group

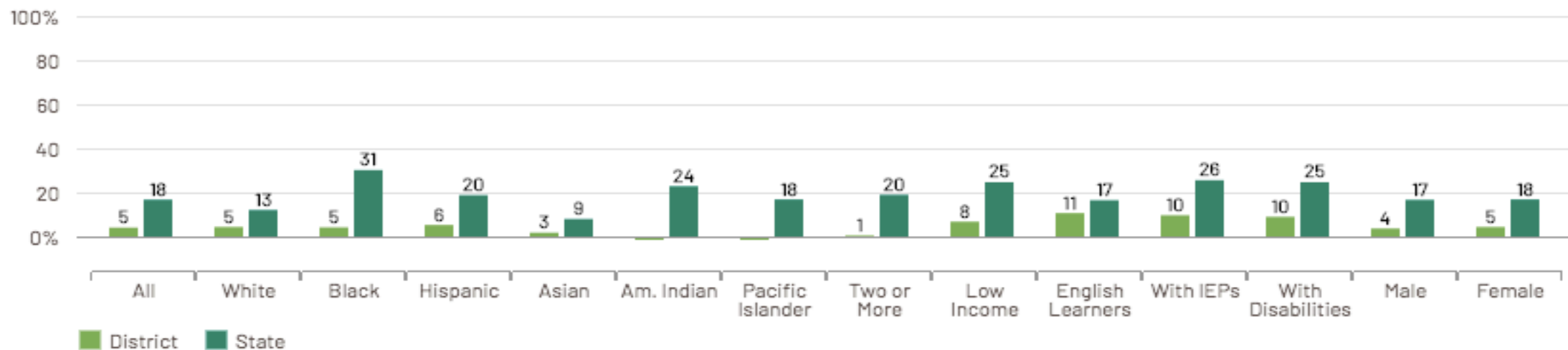

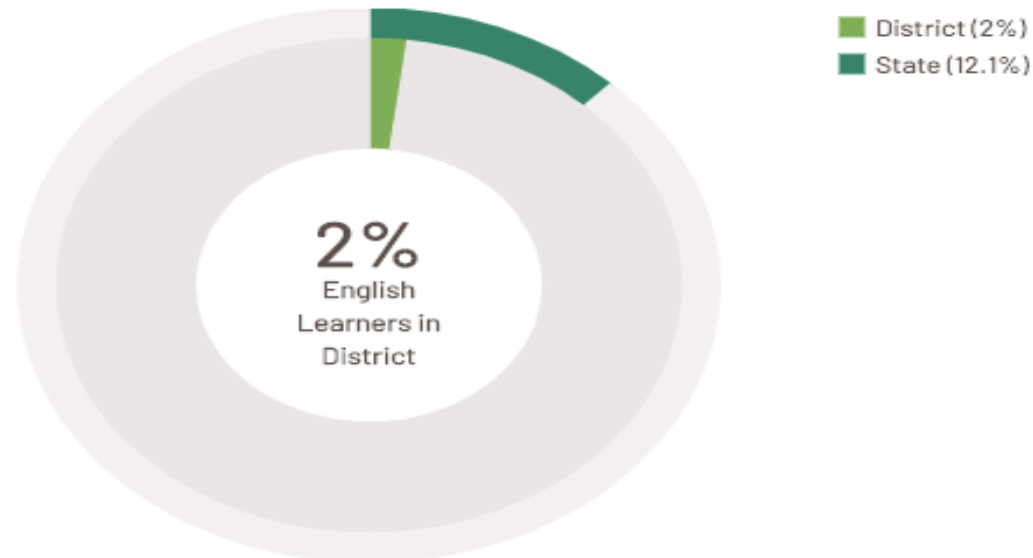

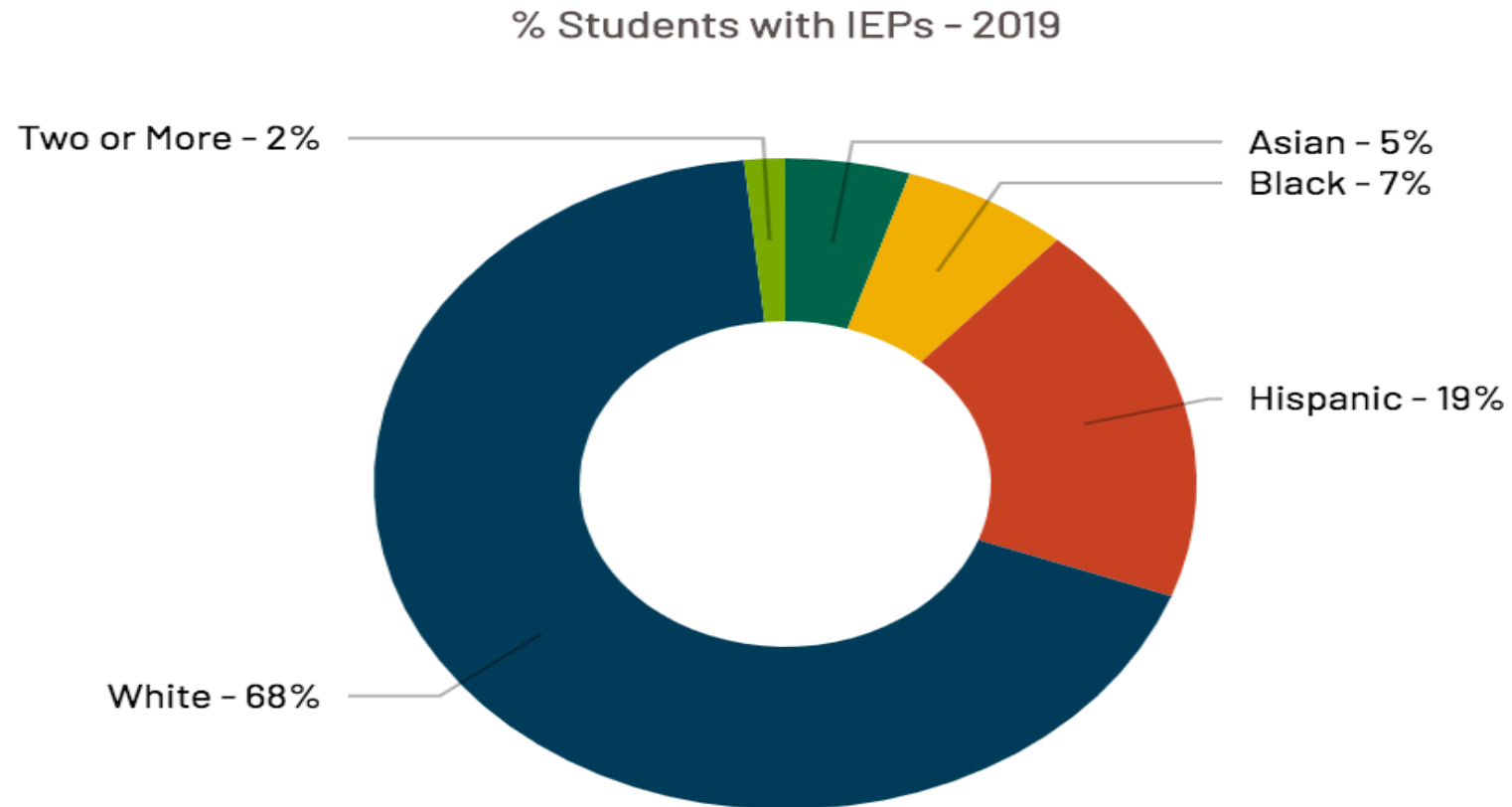

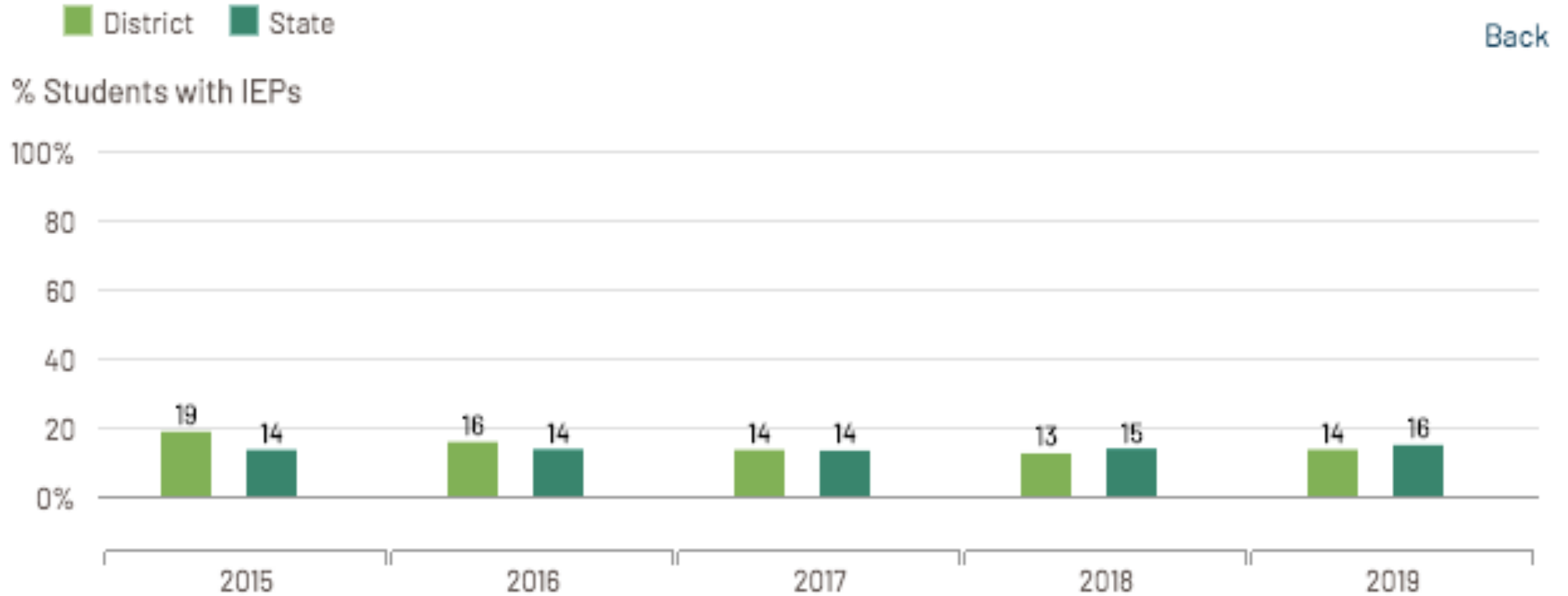

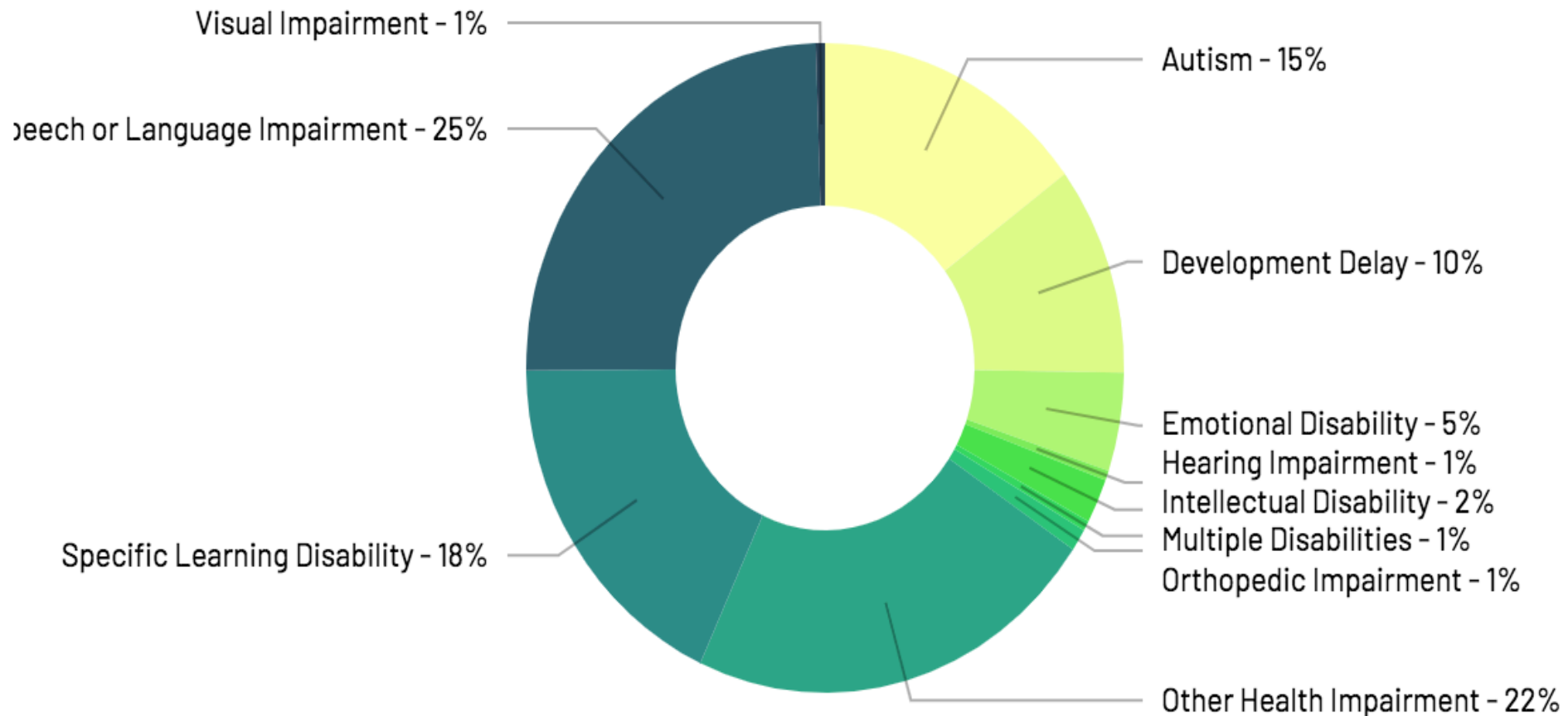

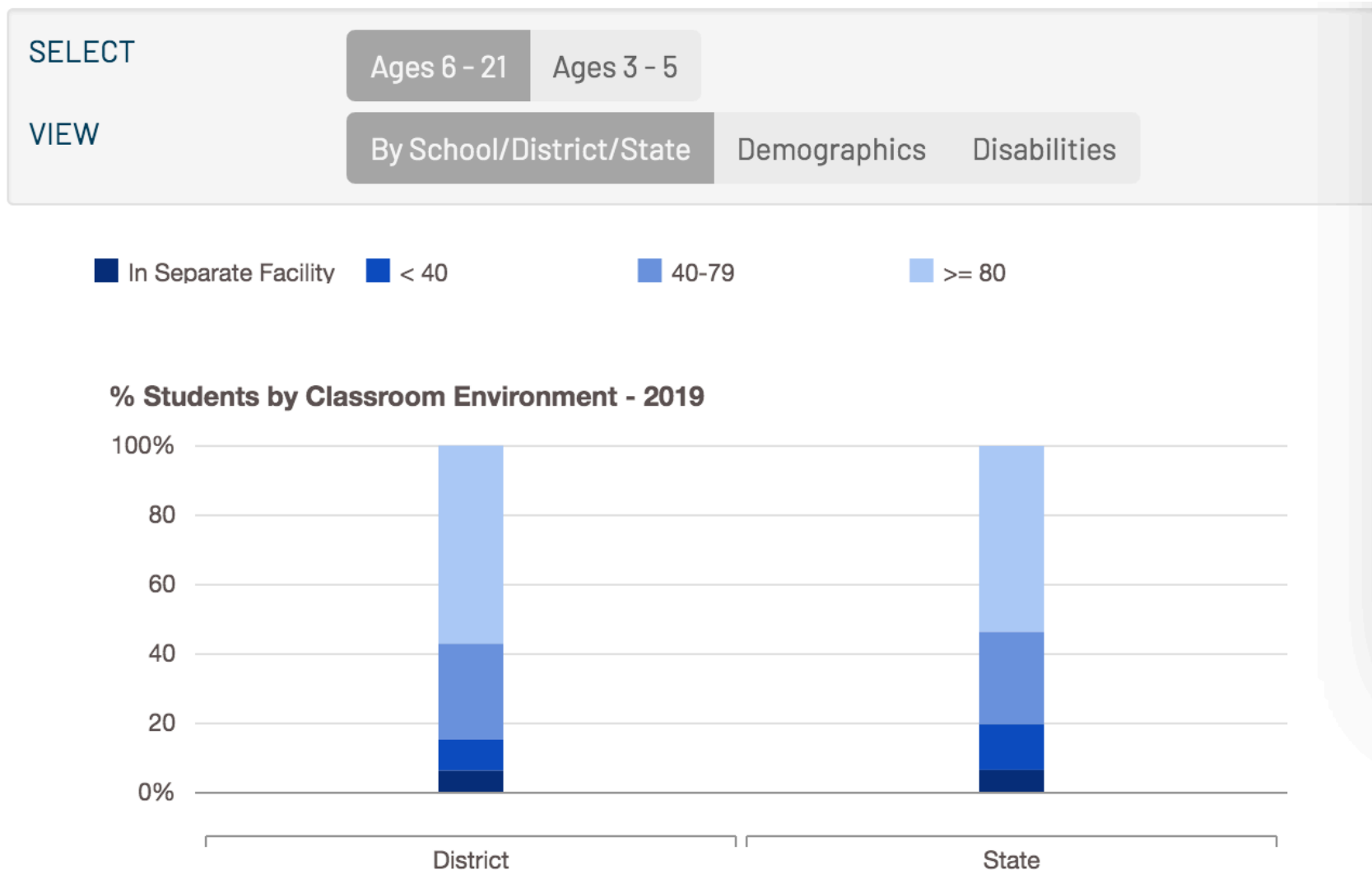
% Students with IEPs - 2019

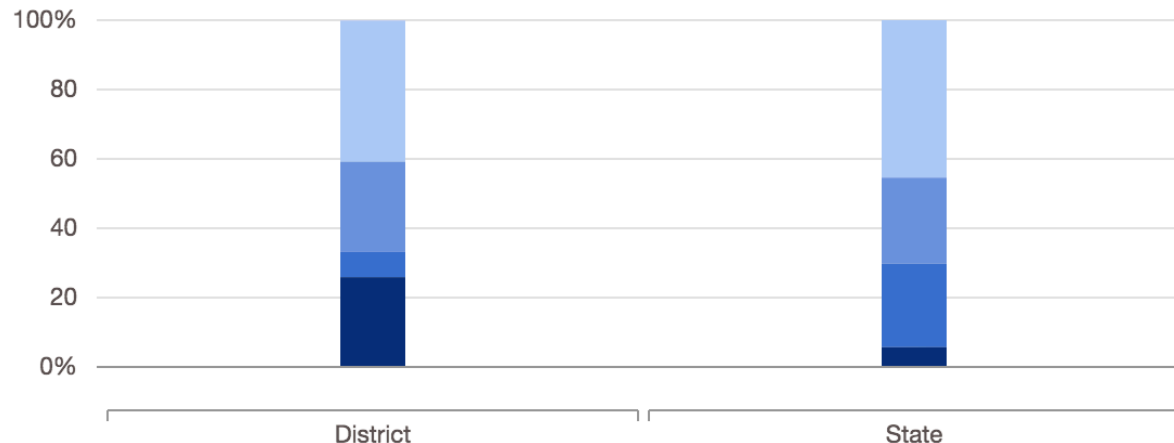

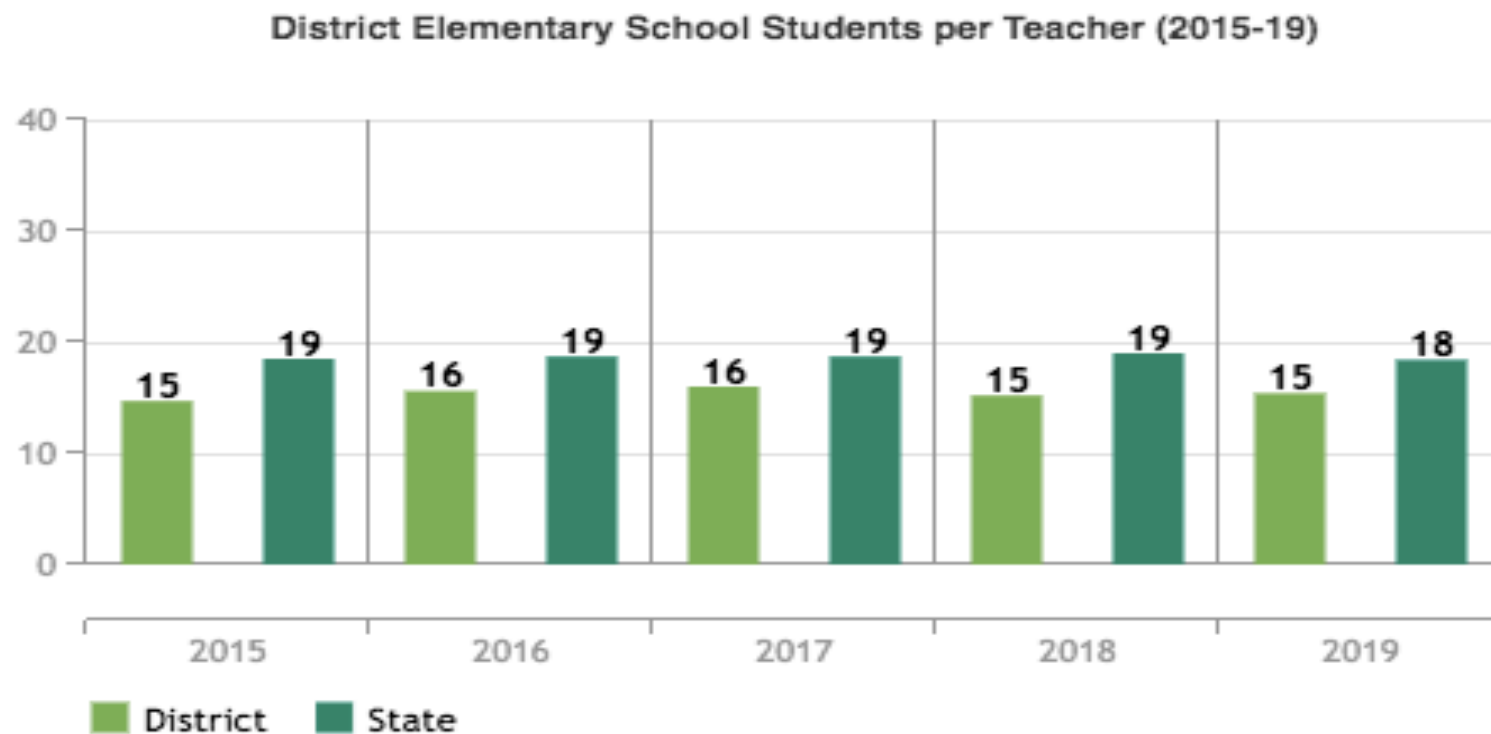

Average number of pupils per teacher

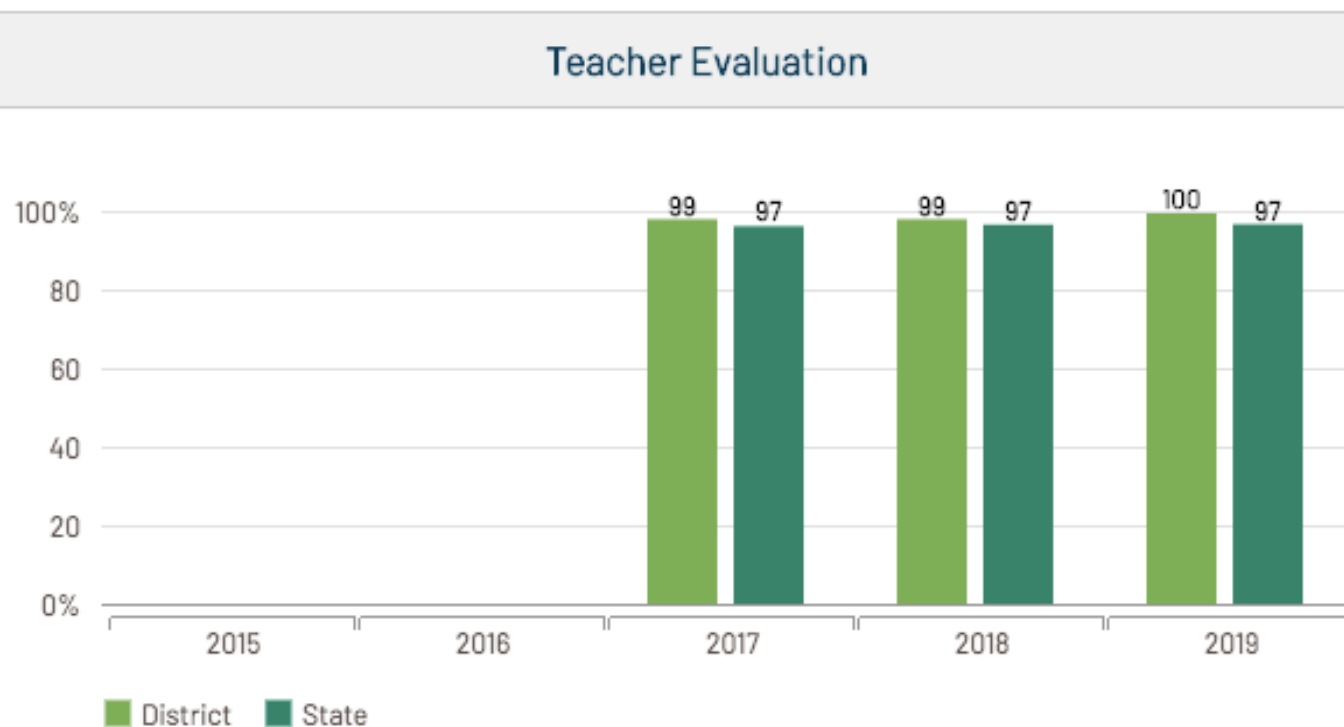

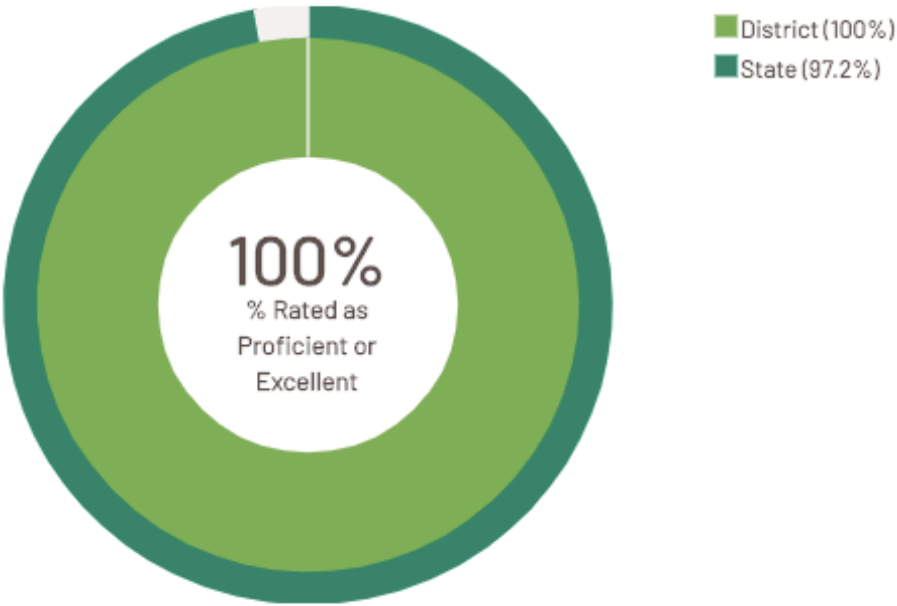

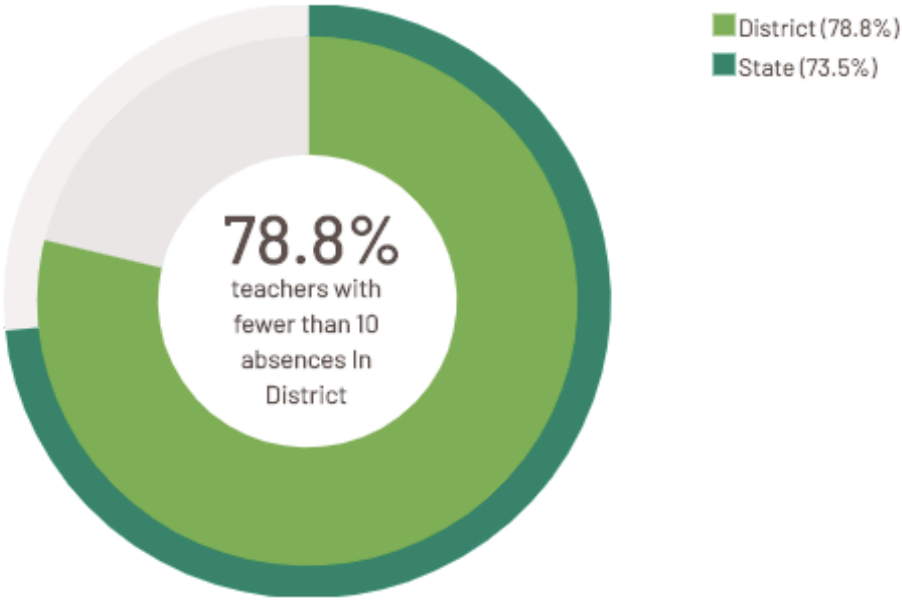

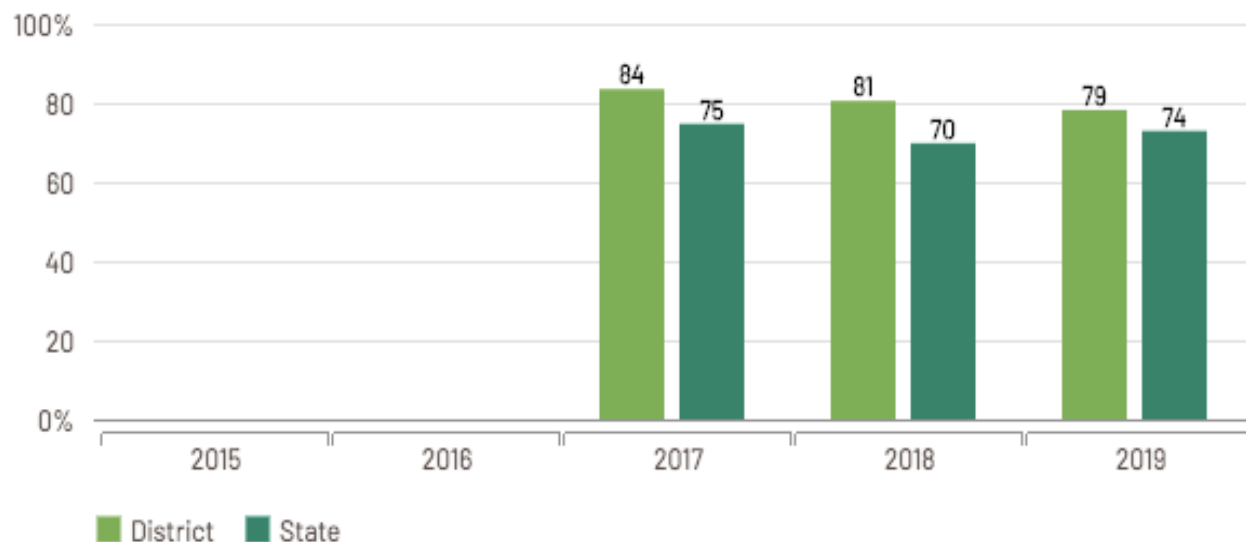

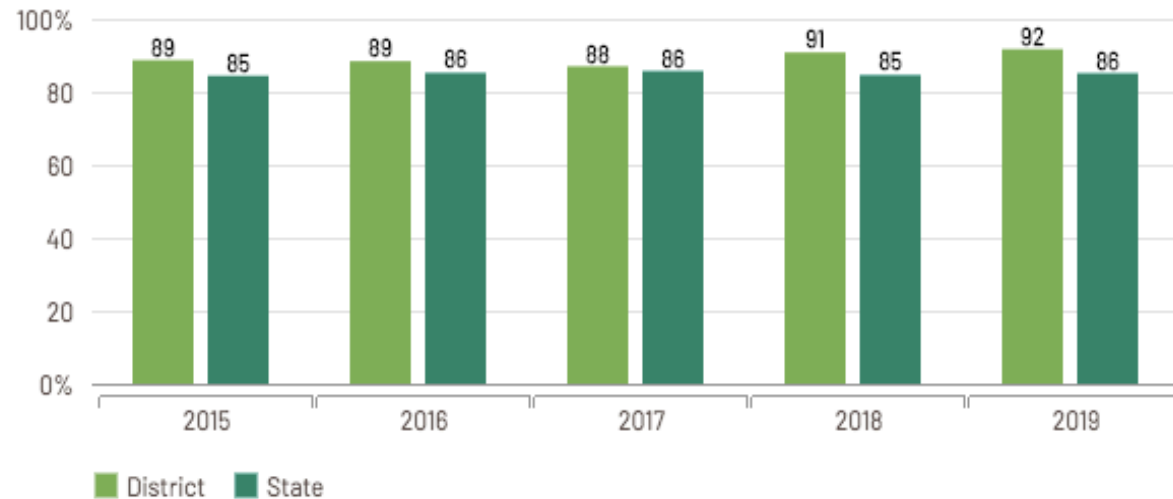

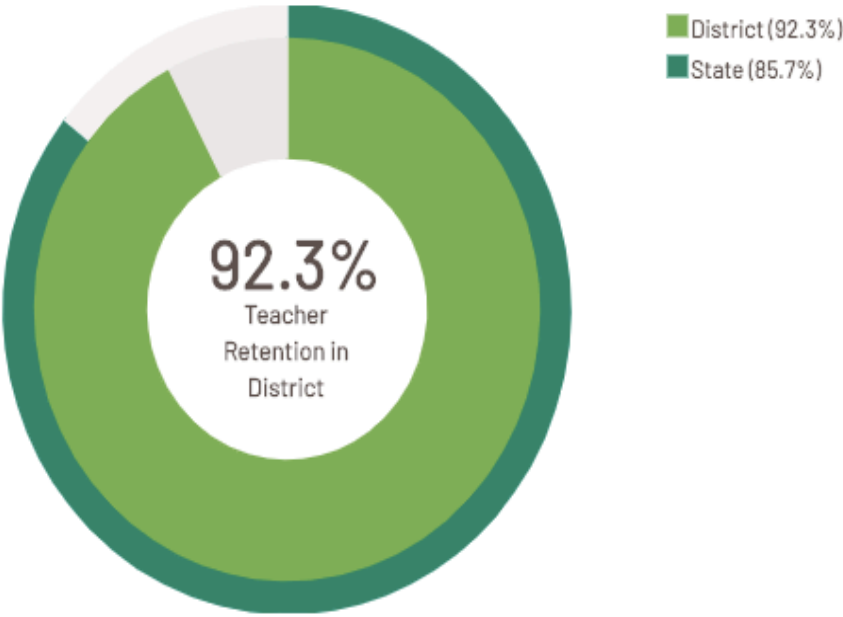

Percentage of teachers holding a bachelor's degree, master's degree, or higher.

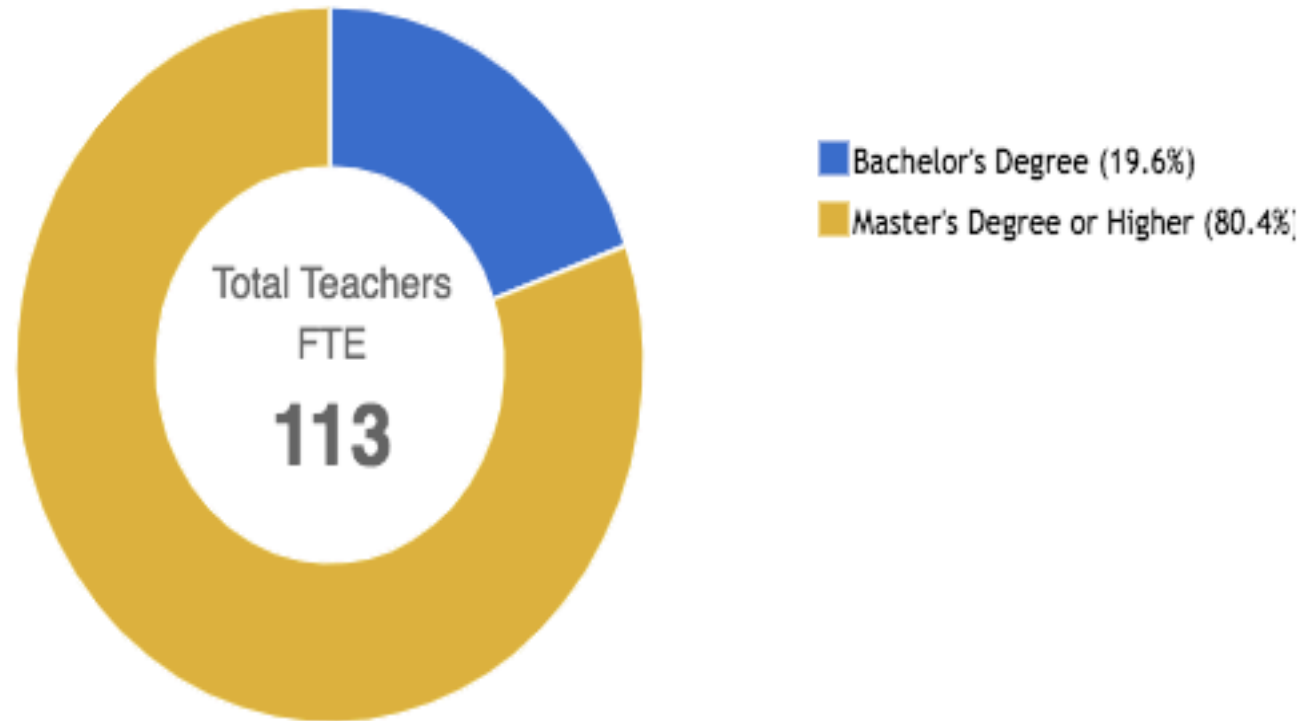

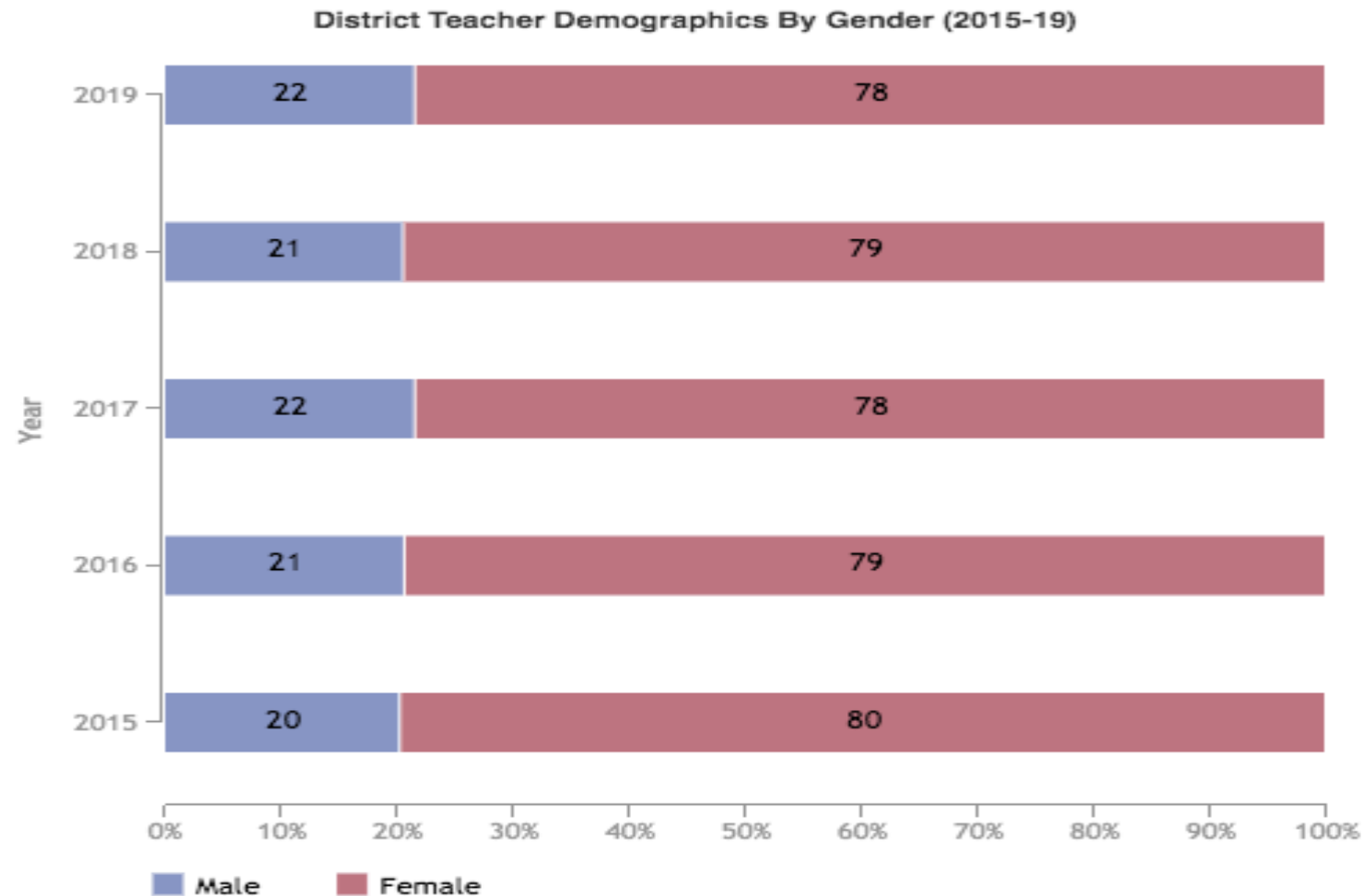

District Teacher Education (2019)

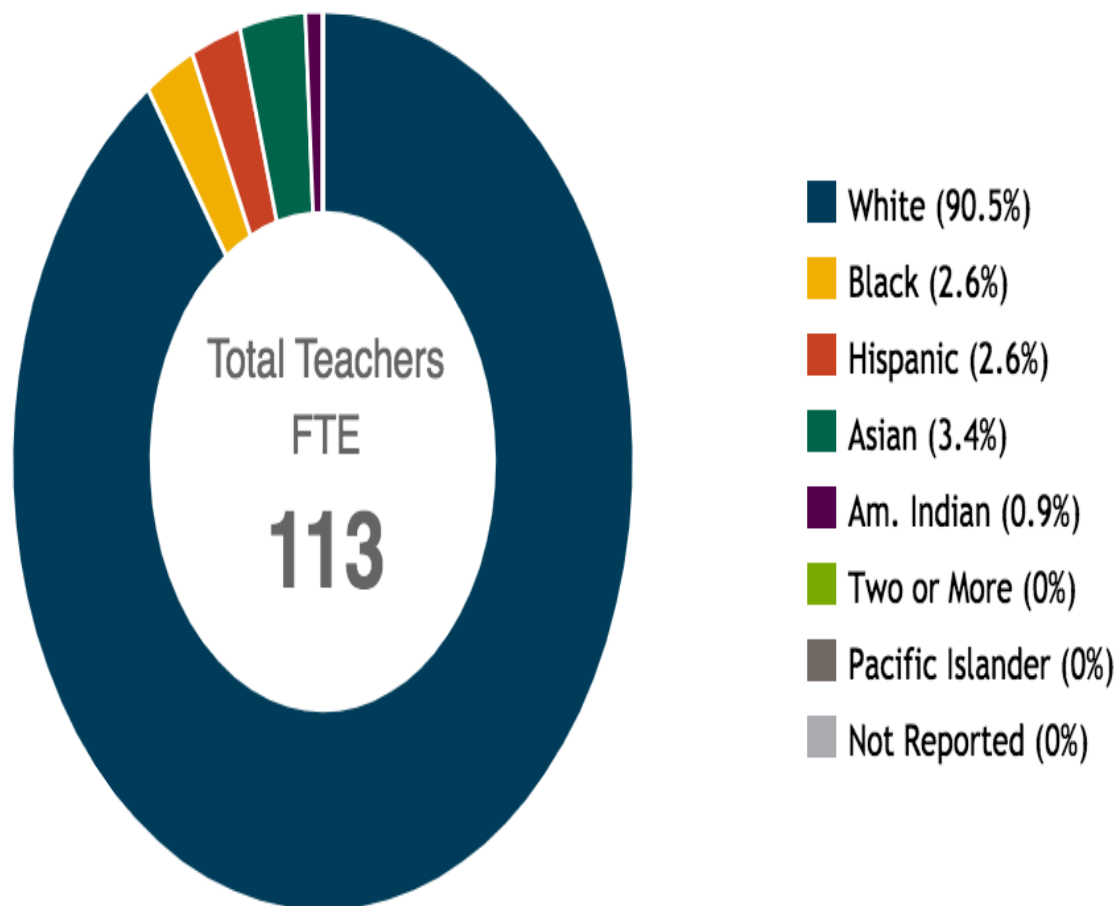
