Education

Student Assessment Data Overview – Mrs. Hickey introduced Dr. Hawley and Phil Earvolino to present the District 90 Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Overview. Mr. Earvolino serves as District 90's independent technical statistician and was in attendance to provide his expertise. Dr. Hawley highlighted various statistics from the most recent Illinois School Report Card as well as discussed the intensions and uses of the MAP assessment. She then presented District's MAP national percentile ranking for Reading and Mathematics from the Fall of 2019 and the Fall of 2020 for grades 5-8 as well as the District's national percentile ranking for Reading and Mathematics from the Spring of 2018, 2019 and 2021 for grades 3-8. A Board discussion ensued. Dr. Condon and Mrs. Hickey thanked Dr. Hawley and Mr. Earvolino for their efforts.

Board Governance

Board of Education and COW Meeting Format Preferences – Dr. Condon reviewed with the Board the recommendation from Director of Technology, Kevin Martin regarding the format and venue for future Board/COW meetings.
